NURSERY DAY AND SESSION TIMES

WHERE TO COME

At the beginning of the session, children are collected by staff at the pedestrian gate. This develops their independence and helps with separating from parents. They walk to nursery with their friends and the nursery staff.

At collection time parents are invited to collect their child from the nursery gate which provides the opportunity for feedback and any questions.



SESSION TIMES

The children in our nursery develop a strong sense of routine, expand their social skills and learn through a variety of well-planned play-based activities. We focus largely on communication and language ensuring our children have the skills needed as they move up through school.

Our morning session starts at 8:30am and finishes at 11:30am.

Our afternoon session starts at 12:30pm and ends at 3:30pm.

The children with 30 hour entitlement stay for lunch and their day runs from 8:30am and ends at 3:30pm with a small charge to cover the lunch time supervision. This includes a hot meal.

As well as learning through play, the children will take part in carefully structured teacher led activities to challenge and enhance their learning.

Each Friday parents are invited into nursery, this is a great opportunity to choose and share a book each week. The children share the rhyme of the week and we discuss the weeks learning.

At nursery we celebrate all of the children's achievements. We love seeing any certificates or awards your child has received outside of school. We also celebrate 10 book awards within nursery and the children receive a small prize.



THE EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE CURRICULUM

The Foundation Stage Curriculum is for all children from birth to the end of Reception year. The curriculum is play based and the children have opportunities to learn through focused activities with an adult and through their own exploration.

There are seven areas of development as follows:

THE PRIME AREAS

Personal, Social and Emotional Development -Self-Regulation, Managing Self, Building Relationships

Communication and Language - Listening, Attention and Understanding, Speaking

Physical Development - Gross Motor Skills, Fine

Motor Skills

THE SPECIFIC AREAS

Literacy - Comprehension, Word Reading, Writing

Mathematics - Number, Numerical Patterns, Shapes

Understanding the World - Past and Present, People and Communities, The Natural World

Expressive Arts and Designs - Creating with materials, Being Imaginative and Expressive

TOPIC ENHANCEMENTS

Alongside the continuous provision we enhance the curriculum through different topics. This gives the children a breadth of experiences and introduces new vocabulary to their learning in a fun and engaging way.

We encourage children to become confident, independent learners, who are curious and ready to investigate the world around them.

If you would like to arrange a visit or to apply for your child's place in our nursery, please complete the application form which can be found in the admissions tab on our website and email it back to nursery.admin@springbank.academy as soon as possible.

Every child is eligible for free Nursery education from the term immediately after their 3rd birthday. Government funding provides a maximum of 15 hours per child, which can be offered during term time only. Some parents are eligible for 30 hours free childcare; you can check your eligibility and find more information using the links below:
