Mountain Rescue

In Year 2, we looked at the important job Mountain Rescue do. We learnt how to contact them, which vehicles they use, how they help injured people and how maps can be used to find and rescue people. We used iPads to search areas on Apple Maps and which direction would be north using a compass. Finally, we acted out an accident in the mountains and talked through how we would help.



I have found an injured person. Call 999 and ask for Mountain Rescue. Use a map to help me say the location.



Someone has fallen when walking. They are shouting for help.



The Mountain Rescue team arrive, and the helicopter may be used to help locate the casualty.



The doctor will access the casualty and decided if they can be safely moved to hospital.
